

Concept of Dialogue on Leadership for IWRM Process (NARBO's 7th IWRM Training) (Draft)

1. Background

Based on the Action Plan 2010-2011 and the result of consultation to NARBO's 3rd Technical Advisory Committee (TAC), NARBO secretariat will conduct the 7th IWRM Training in Japan 2011. As we explained at the 2nd TAC which was held in 2009, 7th Training is prepared for above senior expert of water resources management in RBOs and Government organizations. Participants of the 5th and 6th IWRM Training who were evaluated excellent will be invited. We prepare the training program along with 'IWRM Guidelines' which was officially introduced at the 5th World Water Forum in Istanbul, Turkey 2009 and result of the international workshop on water and history which will be held in 2011.
