First Session: How can we develop capacity of RBO on IWRM implementation ?

- Strengthen their capacities to accelerate the implementation of IWRM processes in river basin development and management;
- All stakeholders, including government, NGOs, and youth have to work together in a transparent, effective manner;
- Resources allocation and budget support to capacity development from government is essential;
- RBOs should facilitate and empower the young generation to support IWRM implementation.

Second Session: Discussion of Certification System for IWRM Professional

- Creating the standard and professional certification system;
- Consider the certification of individuals and RBOs (as organisations) ;
- The Certification of RBOs should not be confused with the current RBO Performance Monitoring system
- Different categories of certification should be considered taking into account the different categories of stakeholders
- NARBO should clearly define the reasons for the certification process.
