## 1. NARBO Forest

- “The Narbo in Corporation with Jasa Tirta II Public Corporation have agreed to create NARBO Pilot Forest with aim to promote IWRM and support to National Partnership Movement for Safeguarding Water Resources (GNKPA)”. (2006)
- PJT II continues to development of NARBO pilot Forest become forest and 2011 as a milestone of planting one billion trees program that was proclaimed by President of Indonesia. (28 November 2012)
- In the Narbo Forest, you can eat your fruit from your trees





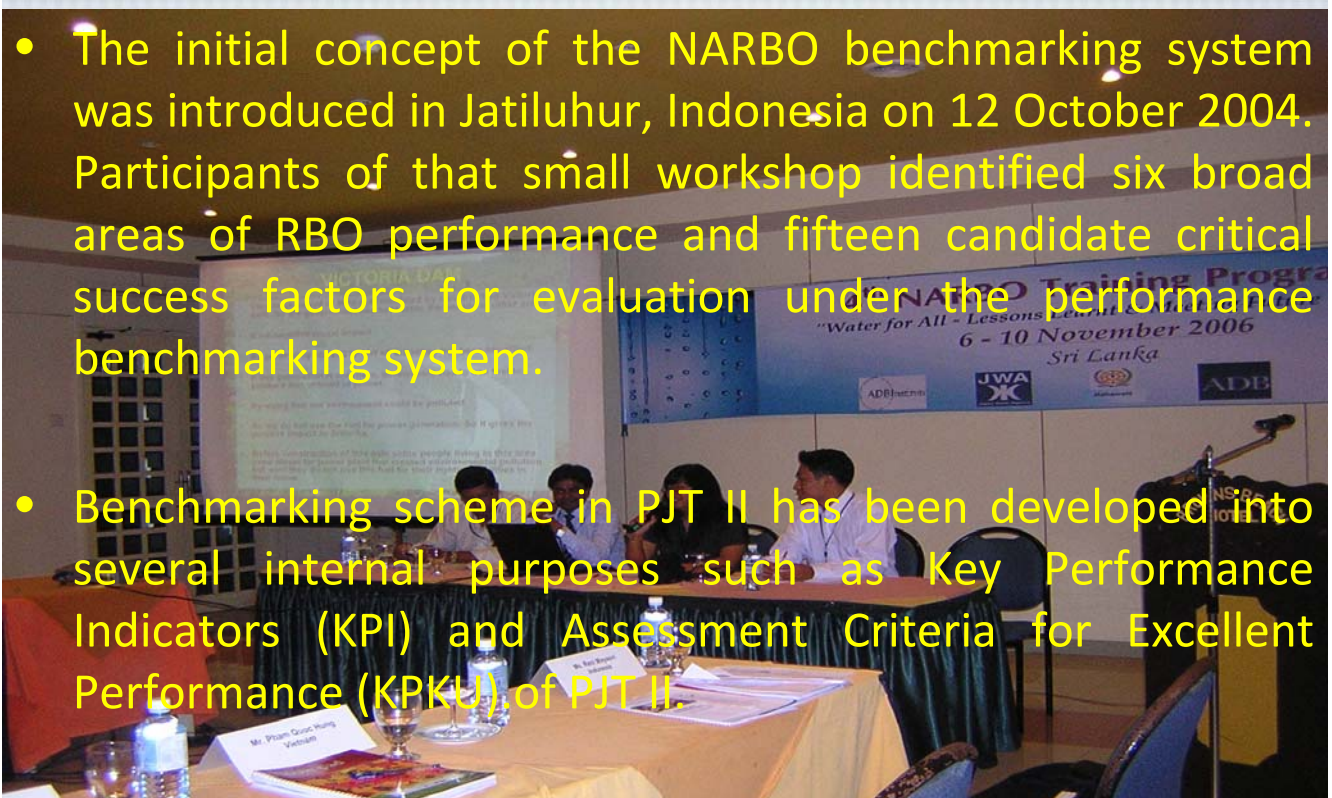
## 2. Cooperation Pilot Project for IWRM

- Cooperation since 2007, project water management qualities of water west Tarum canal continued to this day in the form of DSS.
- In the manufacture of Early Warning System (KOICA) in the upper Citarum River, PJT II as a supporter or support both data and power.



## 3. Implementation Benchmarking

- The initial concept of the NARBO benchmarking system was introduced in Jatiluhur, Indonesia on 12 October 2004. Participants of that small workshop identified six broad areas of RBO performance and fifteen candidate critical success factors for evaluation under the performance benchmarking system.
- Benchmarking scheme in PJT II has been developed into several internal purposes such as Key Performance Indicators (KPI) and Assessment Criteria for Excellent Performance (KPKU) of PJT II.





## 4. Training and Trainer

- Training for technician and high level manager in Korea (K-Water) on 2011 and 2012
- Training Lecturer in Kadmandu - Nepal in June 2012
