#### **BACKGROUND**

- Water resource is the most important element for the survival of human and ecosystem
- Water resource should be conserved and wisely utilized by all stake holders
- In Indonesia, drought and flood disaster have reached the critical level causing much changes to human life and sustainability of eco-system

#### **INDONESIA WATER FORUM (1)**

- In order to achieve higher efficiency in the management water resources, assembly of all stakeholders had been conducted
- Indonesia Water Forum had been conducted in November 2000, then followed by Indonesia Water Forum II in March 2002
- Participant of Indonesia Water Forum consisted of representatives from stake holders in water resource management

- Participants of the Indonesia Water Forum I come to a common perception on the following issues:
  - 1. Realization of an efficient and sustainable water resource development and utilization for the people welfare

#### **INDONESIA WATER FORUM (3)**

- 2. Commitment on policy reform:
- (-) revision of the existing water sector policy and establish National Water Council
- (-) institutional arrangement of water resources funding at river basin level
- (-) institutional arrangement for water service fee and water pollution pay for water quality management
- (-) democratic, selective and gradual transfer of irrigation management to qualified Water Users Association

#### **INDONESIA WATER FORUM (4)**

- Indonesia Water Forum II declared two statements, i.e. :
  - (a) Establish Indonesia Water Partnership (IWP) as a national networking for water resources stake holders and appointed representatives to set up IWP Secretariat
  - (b) Recommend on the future policy for flood mitigation
