### **Training Components**

The eight-day training will include:

- presentations from internationally recognized experts in IWRM and associated issues (e.g. community engagement, institutional and governance arrangements, biodiversity, water resources planning, flooding, water quality monitoring, reporting) from throughout Asia,
- two full-day field study visits of the Vu Gia-Thu Bon River Basin supported by local IWRM practitioners (this river basin case study is central to the training as it embodies many of the issues found in river basin management throughout Asia),
- small and whole group discussions of the materials presented (together with lessons from the field study visits, these will allow participants to test and build their understanding of the keys for success with IWRM),
- participants' presentations and a poster session (these will further cement participants' understanding of IWRM, and allow them to look at how these new insights will impact on their own practice of IWRM).

Participants will get the CD-Rom including all presentation materials at the end of the training.

### **Draft of Schedule**

- Day 0 (29 Nov) Participants arrive at Da Nang.
- Day1 (30 Nov) Opening and lectures on IWRM
- Day2 ( 1 Dec) Lectures on IWRM(Sectoral approach)
- Day3 (2 Dec) Lectures on IWRM
- Day4 (3 Dec) Study Visit
- Day5 (4 Dec) Study Visit
- Day6 (5 Dec) Group work
- Day7 (6 Dec) Special lecture and Group work
- Day8 (7 Dec) Presentation by each participant
- Day 9 (8 Dec) Participants go back to each country.

### **Assignment**

Participants are required to prepare for the materials of poster session and bring them to the venue. Format of the poster session will be sent to the participants at the end of October 2009.

### **Recommendations**

Participants are recommended to bring laptop in which Microsoft Powepoint was installed to the training. We require laptop to prepare for group and individual presentation.

### **Financial Support**

Based on NARBO's Guideline on Financial Support, the following cost items can be supported:

#### **1. NARBO member**

- 1) Return international airfare (most direct and economical route from country of origin to Da Nang)
- 2) Incidental cost (lump sum of US\$40 to cover airport taxes, airport transfers and visa fees)
- 3) Accommodation charges (up to 9 nights)
- 4) Per diem of up to US\$15/day
- 5) Local transportation costs including study visits
- 6) Meals
- 7) Technical materials (soft copy and hard copy)

### **Registration Fee**

All participants (both from NARBO member organizations and non-NARBO member organizations) have to pay the registration fee to cover part of the training costs, as follows:

**NARBO member organization – US\$200 per 1 person**

**Non-NARBO member organization – US\$500 per 1 person**
