







NARBO RBO-Performance Benchmarking

- Small Workshop on Benchmarking, Jatiluhur, Indonesia, October 2004
- Members Consultation Workshop on Benchmarking, Batu, Indonesia, November 2004
- Launching of Performance Benchmarking, Bali, Indonesia, September 2005
- Piloting NARBO's Performance Benchmarking Tool and Peer Review Process Jatiluhur, Indonesia, Oktober 2006
- Peer Review Process in Mahaweli Authority, Sri Lanka, December 2006
- A benchmarking exercise was conducted in 2006-2008 for 10 Asian RBOs: one in Sri Lanka, one in the Philippines, one in Vietnam, and seven in Indonesia

NARBO Benchmarking Tools

The NARBO-RBO Performance Benchmarking use a set of 14 performance indicators clustering in 5 Key Performance Area as follows:

Indonesian RBO Performance Benchmarking (1/2)

Benchmarking is now applied as a standard practice for Indonesian RBOs. The approach is presently being consolidated and streamlined for applications elsewhere in Asia.

CRBOM in collaboration with Directorate General for Water Resources conducted RBO-Performance Benchmarking for Indonesian RBOs.

RBO-Performance Benchmarking for Indonesian RBOs is implemented with the following steps:

- a. Self Assessment and Peer Reviewer training
- b. Socialization to the RBO's stuff
- c. Self Assessment and Action Plan Program
- d. Peer Review
- e. Reporting
- f. Action Plan Evaluation
